- A. DESIGN REVIEW PERMIT – 6861 FIVE STAR BL – HRNSP PARCEL 45B, GOLDEN CORRAL -- (FILE # DRPMOD 05-01).** The applicant requests approval of a Design Review Permit Modification for plans to construct a 10,750 square foot restaurant on Pad B of the Fairway Commons I shopping center at the southwest corner of Five Star Boulevard and Fairway Drive. (Lindbeck)
- B. DESIGN REVIEW PERMIT, LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT, AND ADMINISTRATIVE PERMIT – 7201-7301 GALILEE RD. – ROSEVILLE OFFICE/WAREHOUSE BUSINESS PARK - (FILE # DRP 04-62, LLA 04-19 & AP 05-03).** The applicant requests approval of a Design Review Permit to construct a 101,015 square foot warehouse and office complex. The application includes a Lot Line Adjustment to merge two parcels into one 5.6 acre parcel, and an Administrative Permit for a parking reduction to reduce the number of spaces required for the warehouse uses within the complex.
