

Residential Non-Electric Solar Panel Permit Requirements

Location of Solar Panels on existing structures must be reviewed and approved for their location and size. The Building Division enforces the current California Building, Residential, Plumbing, Mechanical and Electrical Codes and Roseville City Ordinances.

To obtain a permit for new solar panels at the Building Division:

- Provide a plot plan showing the location and orientation of the solar panels.
- Provide the specifications and installation of the solar panels on the existing roof.
- Engineered design may be required for the location of the Solar Panels on some structures.

Details shall include:

- Details showing clearly the connection of the new panels to the existing roof and the weather proofing of all penetrations.
- Provide an engineered design if the supports of the new solar panels do not comply with CRC Section R802 for conventional framing or engineered trusses (e.g. aluminum patio cover).

Note: Please check with your homeowners association for any other requirements.
