The City of Roseville's Code Enforcement program occasionally comes across a property that is in need of a good cleanup. Unfortunately, some property owners and/or tenants are unable to clean the property themselves due to medical conditions, disabilities, financial hardships, etc. and need some assistance. Since our goal is to serve our community through voluntary compliance, Code Enforcement has put together a list of various clubs, organizations, volunteers, etc. that could serve as a resource for some possible assistance. These volunteer cleanup activities come from many different community services, such as non-profit organizations, church groups, boy and girl scouts, high schools, rotary/kiwanis clubs and local businesses.

6. City of Roseville – Rehabilitation and clean-up projects.
- Housing Rehabilitation Program – Administrated through the City of Roseville's Housing Division, provides assistance in the form of grants and loans to low-income homeowners to make health and safety repairs to their homes.  - Residential Refuse Collection - For yard and garage clean-up projects, 6-yard dumpsters can be rented through the Solid Waste Division for \$105.04 for one week. Each additional pick-up during the week is \$52.80. Construction or demolition dumpsters are also available for rent. Sizes range from 10 yard dumpsters for concrete to 20- yard, 25-yard and 30-yard dumpster for construction and demolition. (An Encroachment Permit is required).
