

POLICY FOR ALLOWING ENCROACHMENT OF DUMPSTERS/PODS ON ROSEVILLE CITY STREETS

 **Any person operating as a refuse hauler must have obtained a non-exclusive franchise agreement from the City. See Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.17.030.**

Dumpsters/Pods measuring more than six and a one-half feet (6.5 feet) in width will be permitted within City right-of-way provided an encroachment permit is first obtained from the City of Roseville, Department of Public Works. The responsibility for obtaining an encroachment permit shall be the property owners, or his/her representative. **The dumpster/pod provider shall ensure the property owner is in receipt of the encroachment permit prior to delivery of the dumpster/pod, otherwise the provider shall remove the dumpster/pod within twenty-four (24) hours following notice.** Failure of provider removal will result in City removal with all incurred expense responsibility to the provider.

Encroachment permits for dumpster/pod placement will be approved provided the following conditions are met, and there is no feasible off-street application.

1. Any dumpster/pod placed on public right of way must have the name, telephone number and address of the owner of the dumpster prominently displayed on at least two sides.
2. All dumpsters/pods placed in City street right of way must be effectively reflectorized. "Effective reflectorization" means that all four sides of the dumpster/pod shall be reflectorized. Each vertical edge of the dumpster shall have a full height reflective strip at least 4" wide to be visible from either direction. There shall also be a horizontal strip at least 4" wide across the full width of each side of the dumpster/pod at its center. The reflectivity shall meet the requirements for barricades of the California State Manual of Traffic Controls.
3. Dumpsters/pods placed where there are curbs and sidewalks must not protrude more than 8 feet into the street from the edge of the pavement with no encroachment into the sidewalk area. On street segments without curbs and sidewalks, dumpsters/pods may not be placed where the vehicular travel width would be restricted. In no case will a dumpster/pod be allowed on a street where they would protrude out to the traveled way. In all cases, a minimum ten (10) foot clear motor vehicle lane shall be maintained within the projected, adjacent street lane lines.
4. Dumpsters/pods may not be placed within 100' of the approach to a stop sign, traffic signal, traffic flasher, curve warning sign or pedestrian crosswalk.
5. Dumpsters/pods will not be allowed on streets without sidewalks, unless adequate provision is made for pedestrians to go around the dumpster off the street.
6. Dumpsters/pods may not be placed in a "no parking" or a "no stopping" zone or within 15-feet of a fire hydrant.
7. No dumpsters/pods shall be placed in any alley, restricting the flow of traffic, unless indicated on the special provisions on the Encroachment Permit and a twelve (12) foot lane shall be maintained for emergency vehicles.
8. As defined in the encroachment permit, dumpsters/pods may be placed on a public street for a maximum of 30 days. One-30 day extension may be requested through the Construction Inspector, (774-5441).
9. Proof of Insurance must be self-certified before an encroachment permit will be issued.
10. Provider shall be responsible for any illicit/pollutant discharge from the trash bin into the storm drain system.
