Subject: RE: Roseville EU Ops Center EIR - Police & Fire Services

The Pleasant Grove Stormwater Retention Basin Project is an existing project in the City's Capital Improvement Program. As of May 31, 2025, the City has spent \$14.8 million purchasing land, conducting environmental work, preparing alternative designs, and preparing studies regarding expected operations and maintenance costs. Most recently, the City has entered contract with Wood Rodgers to prepare a Subsequent EIR, conduct field studies and site surveys, design alternatives, prepare full construction documents, and acquire all permits necessary for construction. As of June 2025, field studies including geotechnical, biological, cultural, and land survey are 80% complete and the alternative designs are approximately 30% complete. The Notice of Preparation (SCH #2024100114) was filed in October 2024, and the draft EIR is expected to be initially released to the public in Fall 2025. The City has also worked with Placer County and County developers on a Memorandum of Agreement for certain Placer County developments to participate in the fee program funding the basin which would make the basin a regional facility. If agreed by all parties, the project would mitigate increased volumetric storm runoff for some County projects as well as City projects. The City intends to construct the Pleasant Grove Stormwater Retention Basin Project in the next five years.
