

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application for City of Roseville, Placer County, CA. Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance Grant Program (PA).

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice for DR-4683-CA was published 9/11/2023. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), federal actions must be reviewed and evaluated for feasible alternatives and for social, economic, historic, environmental, legal, and safety considerations. EO 11988 and EO 11990 requires FEMA to consider alternatives and provide a public notice of any proposed actions in or affecting floodplains or wetlands. This notice may also fulfill requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).

This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within a Special Flood Hazard Area. FEMA has determined the only practicable alternative is to fund the repairs of Roseville Power Plant 2 access road embankment and Saugstad Park. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements. There is a potential for the facilities to be impacted by future flooding events due to its location within the Zone AE. The proposed work will take place in wetlands per the United States Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory and will have little potential to impact or affect wetland values.

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Proposed Work and Purpose: Heavy storm flow washed out creek embankment at two locations and washed out trail. For Roseville Power Plant 2 Access, the applicant added 80 standard gravel bags along bridge embankment and 32 super sacks along bridge embankment in-kind. For Saugstad Park, the applicant replaced lost embankment material with Rip Rap and created a 190' X 4' v-ditch with 4" X 6" rip rap lining. Additionally, the applicant replaced damaged 1,500' X 10' X 2.5" asphalt trail and installed backing materials (3/4" Class II Base Rock being installed 2' wide X 2.5" thick) on both sides of the trail to prevent the asphalt from unraveling.

Project Alternatives:

- (1) *(No Action)* This alternative would result in loss of recreational space and road access. If the damage is not repaired, then adverse economic and social impacts may occur and continued negative impacts may be experienced.
- (2) *(Repair in-kind and Repair with Minimization)* Repairs made in kind within Saugstad Park may result in similar damages from future flood events. Minimization measures for Roseville Power Plant 2 Access were not practicable due to temporary nature of the path it protects.
- (3) *(Relocation)* Floodplain avoidance by relocating the facilities are not a practicable alternative as Saugstad Park facilitates open space usage and recreational use and Roseville Power Plant 2 Access is functionally dependent on its location in order to provide safe access across the stream system.

Comments: This will serve as the final public notice regarding the above-described action funded by the FEMA Public Assistance program.
