

Public Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Pleasant Grove Wastewater Treatment Plant Electrical Expansion Project

The City of Roseville (City) is releasing a Draft Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) on the proposed Pleasant Grove Wastewater Treatment Plant (PGWWTP) Electrical Expansion Project (project) for public review. The IS/MND has been prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Project Description and Location: The City is proposing to consolidate and expand the PGWWTP electrical supply from Roseville Electric Utility and PGWWTP's emergency generators into a single expandable facility. The project would include construction of a multi-purpose, concrete masonry block switchgear and generator electrical building (Electrical Building No. 3), a 12-kilovolt (kV) utility feed, two new generators with diesel fuel storage, and a plant drain pump station for stormwater and facility drain collection. Two 2,500-kilowatt (kW) generators would be installed as part of the project with space reserved for two additional generators to be installed in the future as the PGWWTP expands. Similarly, the bulk diesel fuel storage includes a dedicated 15,000-gallon, double-walled steel storage tank for each generator with room to add two additional tanks as needed. The project facilities would be constructed within the existing PGWWTP boundary and immediately south of the existing PGWWTP boundary located at 5051 Westpark Drive in Roseville, California. The area immediately south of the PGWWTP and east of the Energy Recovery Facilities is City-owned property, intended for future wastewater treatment infrastructure. The PGWWTP is located on a 110-acre parcel located west of Del Webb Sun City Sierra Pines Golf Course, north of Pleasant Grove Boulevard, and south of Blue Oaks Boulevard.

Public Review Period: The Draft IS/MND is being circulated for a 30-day public review period from **August 24, 2026** through **September 28, 2026**. Written comments need to be submitted at the address or e-mail listed below by no later than **5:00 p.m. on September 28, 2026**.
