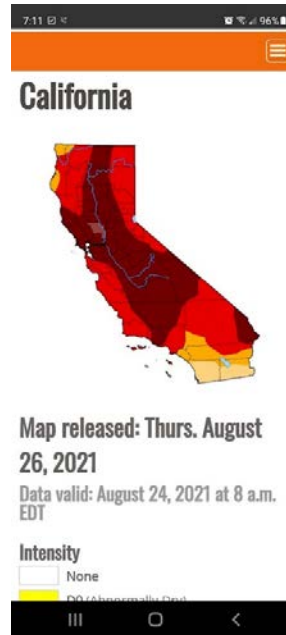
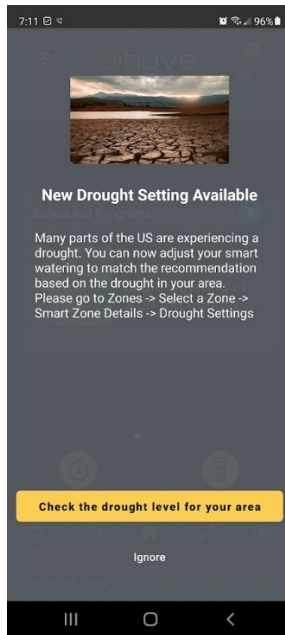
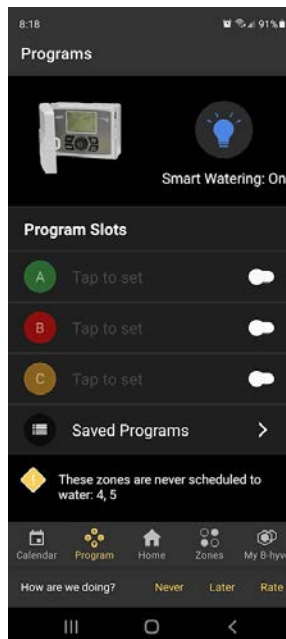
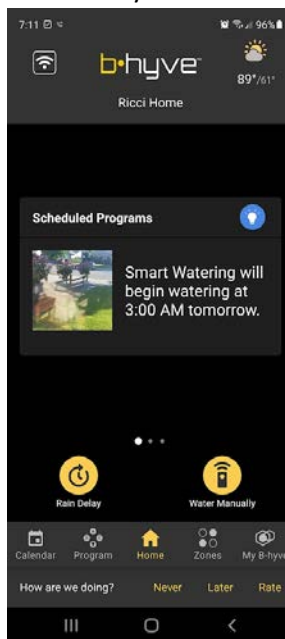


Inputting Drought Settings into Orbit B-Hyve Controllers

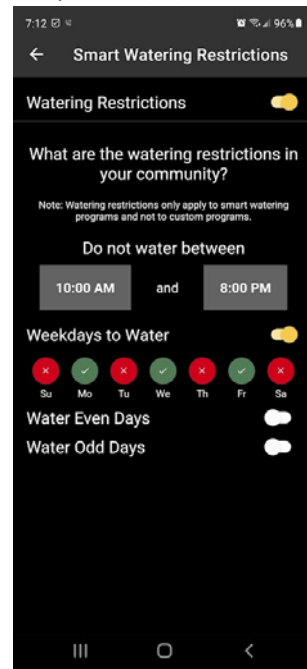
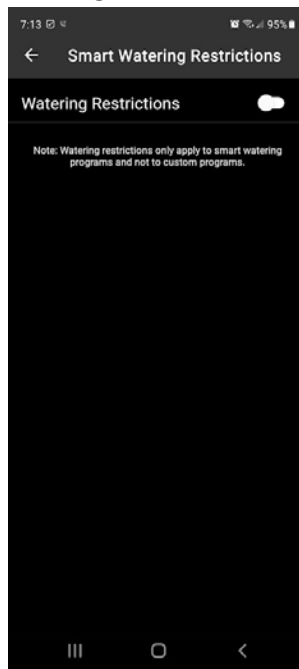
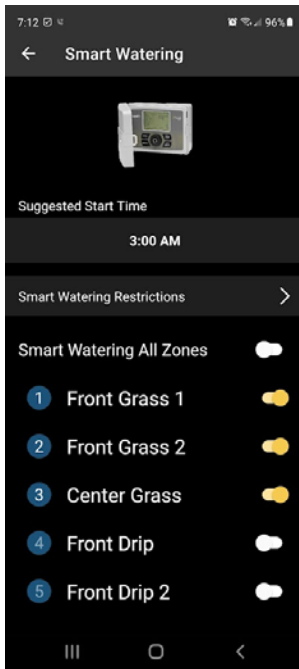
- Find the app on your device and open it. When it opens you will be greeted with the option of looking at drought conditions. This is not required, but is helpful information. Use as desired.



- On the Main screen, tap the "Program" icon (second icon from the left) at the bottom of the screen. Can tap the blue light bulb up above in the right corner. This is also a good time to remind users that they shouldn't have any of the traditional programs (A through C) active and should only be smart watering.



- On the next screen tap “Smart Watering Restrictions” and when taken to the next screen make sure the “switch” next to “Smart Watering Restrictions” is switched to yellow (on)



- Allowed watering days will be listed with a green check mark whereas restricted days will be listed with red x marks. Tap these icons to change watering days to non-watering days and vice versa. It is also a good idea to put in 10:00 AM and 8:00 PM in the “Do not water between” sections. Reminder that these restrictions only work under the “Smart Watering” program and will not restrict watering days on traditional programs (A through C).
